The organizer has the right not to accept the application without giving a reason.

A double-sided photocopy of the dog's pedigree certificate - valid for all dogs registered for the exhibition - and a photocopy of the test certificate or a copy of the confirmation of obtaining the title VSV, KV, NV, European winner, World winner, C.I.B., C.I.E. and CH of the FCI member country when placing the dog in the winner class.

Exhibited dog classes, titles, competitions:

1. **Puppy class 4 - 6 months**
2. **Youth class 6 - 9 months**
3. **Veteran class from 8 years old**
4. **Junior class 9 - 18 months**
5. **Intermediate class 15 - 24 months**
6. **Open class from 15 months**
7. **Winner class from 15 months. Dogs with the titles C.I.B., C.I.E., CH of FCI member countries, VSV, KV, NV, European winner and World winner can be included in this class.**

Kooikerhondje Regional Club Show Titles:

Class Winner – Exc1 in Junior, Open, Intermediate, Winners and Veterans. Regional winner – male / female from the competition of class winners: intermediate classes, open, winners.

Competitions Regional Kooikerhondje Club Show:

- Best pair of dogs - for a female and male dog of the same breed, owned by one owner or co-owner, who were judged at the show.
- The best breeding group – for at least 3 and at most 5 individuals of the same breed, coming from one breeder and min. from two different sires or dams that were judged at the show.
- The best puppy of the Regional Club Show - both a dog and a bitch from the puppy class enter the competition, awarded with the mark Very promising 1
- Best youth Regional Club Shows - both male and female from the youth class enter the competition with the Very Promising 1 mark
- The best junior individual of the Regional Club Show - a dog and a female from the junior class enter the competition with the grade V1, Class Winner
- The best veteran of the Regional Club Show - both a dog and a bitch from the veteran class enter the competition, awarded with the grade V1, Class Winner
- Winner of the Regional Club Show - a dog and a female enter the competition with the title of Regional Winner, Best Young Individual, Best Veteran

Documents for participation in the exhibition: entry form, dog's pedigree certificate and vaccination certificate or Pet passport.

Veterinary conditions:

- all animals must be clinically healthy,
- must be equipped with a passport or vaccination certificate, must have a valid vaccination against rabies.

Protests:

A protest against the referee's decision is not admissible. Protests can only be made for formal reasons against violations of exhibition regulations and propositions. The protest must be submitted in writing - at the same time as the deposit of CZK 1,600 before the end of the assessment in the circles. If the protest is not recognized, the principal is forfeited in favor of the organizer.

General provisions:

- The exhibition is open to dogs and bitches of all breeds of group VIII. FCIs that are classified in the KCHLS (except retrievers) and entered in books recognized by FCIs who have reached the age required for inclusion in the class on the day of the show. The discount for the second and next dog can only be applied if the name of the owner or co-owners is the same as the 1st application. Every other change on the second application, e.g. addition of co-ownership, will be taken as a new application at full price. The first dog is not considered an individual registered in the class of puppies, juveniles, veterans and class of honor. In the case of imported dogs, the original abbreviation of the studbook and the registration number of the country from which the dog comes must also be stated on the application. Dogs in joint ownership with an entry in a foreign studbook and without a ČLP entry are considered dogs of non-members of the KCHLS. The organizer of the exhibition is not responsible for damages caused by the dog or the exhibitor, nor for the death or loss of the dog. Dogs are not allowed to run free. The Exhibition Committee may refuse to accept an application without giving a reason. Excluded from the show are bitches in a higher stage of pregnancy, lactating bitches and individuals with an operative or other veterinary intervention to remove a defect in the dog's exterior. It is forbidden to adjust the coat, skin or muzzle of the dog with anything that changes their structure, color or shape. It is forbidden to groom the dog in the area of the exhibition center with the help of any substances or aids. Combing and brushing is

allowed. Violation of this provision may result in the immediate exclusion of the dog from participation in the exhibition. Loud encouragement of dogs from outside the ring (so-called double-handling) is prohibited. It is also forbidden to attract the attention of dogs from outside the ring in any other way (for example, using whistles, toys, food, calling the dog, etc.). Violation of this prohibition may result in the exclusion of the dog from judging.

- Unless otherwise stated in the propositions, the provisions of the FCI International Show Rules and the ČMKU Show Rules apply. In the event that the exhibition does not take place for objective reasons, the fees will be used to cover the costs of the exhibition.
- Driving puppies (except those registered for the exhibition) and their sale is prohibited at the exhibition. The organizer is not responsible for damage caused by the dog or the exhibitor, nor for the death or loss of the dog. Dogs are not allowed to run free.

My name is Astrid Straaijer and I live in a small but beautiful village called Nederasselt near the river "De Maas" in the Netherlands. Kooikerhondje have been part of my life since childhood. In 2000, I started my own breeding program under the name "Qunack's Favor". Since then, I have bred several litters. In breeding, I focus on character, health, and type. Character is very important to me because kooikers are primarily family pets.

Together with my daughter, we attend dog shows throughout Europe. During these trips, we enjoy a lot of fun with our dogs and achieve great results. Several champions in different countries have come from our breeding, and even World and European winners.

In 2013, we acquired a female Lagotto Romagnolo, with whom we later bred one litter.

After years of breeding and showing, I decided to start studying to become a judge in 2010. In 2012, I passed the exams for my own breeds - Kooikerhondje and Lagotto Romagnolo - and became an official judge for both breeds.

I have already judged Kooikerhondje in 6 different countries. For me, the most important thing is that both the owner and the dog enjoy having fun together in the ring. As a judge, you must have patience, and when judging kooikers, some treats definitely come in handy.

I'm really looking forward to coming to the Czech Republic and judging your kooikers.
